This is how you get to my radio site: on computer (online) ipad, or by cell phone. Computer is my best option. 1. Go to the website: www.boldbravemedia.com.
2. My program is in the 200’s, so select or scroll down to the **200**’s.
3. Then notice the days of the week printed (hard to see) printed in sequence. **Select THURSDAY!** (My program is always on Thursday!)
4. Then look for the time slot of 7:00 PM, EST. On Nov. 1st, you will see my face and the title: “Dr. T., Ph.D.” Then hit the **listen** tab! That’s it!
